BIO

Kaisu Koivisto works across installations, photography, sculptures and video. The thematic focus of her artistic practice is rooted in the notions of place, history and landscape, and in the different ways in which environments are represented, commodified, and stereotyped.

The relationship between natural phenomena and technologies is an ongoing subject of exploration for Koivisto. She investigates the intersections of nature and culture and the modes in which mankind harnesses and exploits – or attempts to control – natural phenomena. How do we look at animals and nature? How is the impact of technologies visible in the environment?

Koivisto's interests are deeply rooted in the North, its landscapes and political dimensions. Her interest in history has led her to explore abandoned Cold War era military areas in Eastern Europe. In her ongoing project New Nuuk Koivisto explores the rapid urbanization and changes in Nuuk, the capital of Greenland.
